


A COMMUNITY-BUILT APPROACH TO AI

Our North Star: AI Augments Human Potential, It Doesn't Replace It.




- Our focus is on using AI to **enhance creativity, critical thinking, and student-centered learning.**


- **Community-Shaped Policy:** Our AI framework was developed with feedback from students, parents, teachers, administrators, and district staff.
- **AUHSD AI Workgroup:** We believe everyone should have a seat at the table when it comes to the future of technology. The AUHSD AI Workgroup includes voices from across our community—from district level staff, credentialed and classified staff, students and families—to guide how we use AI to enhance both the classroom and the workplace.
- **Open Dialogue:** We host AI Town Halls and family workshops to create a space for families, teachers and staff to engage, ask questions, and contribute to the ongoing conversation about AI in AUHSD. In addition to holding an AUHSD AI Workgroup that meets quarterly.



We Focus on Critical AI Competencies, Not Just Access to Tools...

It's not enough to have AI tools; our students and staff must know how to use them **effectively, ethically, and critically**. We are dedicated to building district-wide AI literacy from the ground up.

- **Baseline Understanding:** A district-wide professional learning video on AI Literacy and Readiness ensures all staff share a common foundation.
- **Continuous Learning:** We provide monthly professional learning on AI topics, impromptu workshops based on site needs, and a menu of AI workshops and lessons for easy classroom integration.



Preparing Future-Ready & Responsible Citizens, Not Just Future Workers...



We are leveraging AI to prepare students to be **informed, ethical, and engaged** citizens in a complex world. Our goal is to foster the core competencies needed for lifelong success.

- **Promoting Academic Integrity:** We focus on teaching the responsible use of AI tools, shifting the culture from punitive measures to one of trust and academic honesty.

- **Empowering Staff:** Provide ongoing, comprehensive AI professional learning for all staff.
- **Ensuring Safety:** Vet every AI tool through our ISR process to protect student and staff data.
- **Student Partnership:** Engage students as co-designers to shape their AI learning experiences.
- **Responsive Implementation:** Use "street data" to ensure AI tools are student and staff-centered and meet real needs.
