HUMAN-CENTERED LEARNING

We aren't here to replace teachers with robots. Our goal is to use AI to strengthen relationships, spark creativity, deepen critical thinking, and encourage agency.



We're leaning into the future, but we're doing it with our eyes wide open and our students' best interests at heart.

LITERACY OVER BANS

We don't believe in gatekeeping. We want our students and staff to be AI literate, meaning they understand how AI works, where it fails, and how to use it ethically.



Staff Role: Teachers model responsible use and stay "in the loop" on AI-generated outputs. Teachers are not "cheater checkers."

Student Role: Kids learn to ask, "Is this helping me learn, or is it learning *for* me?" Students are treated with trust.

COMMON LANGUAGE

We use a 4-level framework for assignments:

- **Level 1 (No AI):** Brain-power only
- **Level 2 (AI Assisted):** AI as a brainstormer or editor
- **Level 3 (AI Collaboration):** Human and AI work side-by-side
- **Level 4 (AI Created):** AI does the heavy lifting (reserved for specific projects)



We only use district-approved tools like MagicSchool, Canva, and Gemini so staff and students don't have to guess about safety.

A WORK IN PROGRESS MINDSET

The district AI Coalition, consisting of teacher leaders and administrators, is the eyes and ears for AI implementation. This team developed our guidebook and monitors the pulse of the building to set goals for future areas of improvement.



Engaging stakeholders through a teacher-led committee, parent focus groups, and student panels allows us to approach AI from multiple perspectives.
